## Children Take Part In Ground-Breaking

The ground breaking ceremony for the new building of the Holy Cross Lutheran Church at 30850 W. Six Mile Rd. was held Sunday, Sept. 11.

Holy Cross was begun as a mission church in 1958. The building program was instituted in Jan., 1964. The building should be completed by June 1967.

The need for a new building was created by the fact that church membership has doubled since 1963.

An interesting fact of the ceremony was that each child in attendance was presented with a small shovel to commemorate the occasion.
