## 'Museum Of Truth' Opens At M. Close Residence

Museum of Truth is the name given to his rock display at Nine Mile Rd. and Halstead by Martin Close. It is open to the public and group tours of Scouts and other organizations are welcome to drop in and learn the secrets of the rocks.

Close has been studying geology for 17 years now and the moving of his place of employment to another site has given him some leisure to complete the work on his rock museum.

Through his years of study, Close has arrived at some interesting theories some of which do not coincide with those currently taught by science. He does not subscribe to the "glacial moraine" explanation of the Great Lakes and other geographical attributes of Michigan.

In 1961 while studying one of Farmington's so-called "glacial moraines" many burnt and ablated rocks were found. It was Kingston Conglomerate, a rock that makes up a great part of the Keweenaw Peninsula of the Lake Superior region.

THE STORY IS LONG, but the gist of it is that "Four thousand years ago at a 22 degree angle out of the southwest billions and billions of tons of iron, copper, uranium, quartz etc. came out of the sky and struck where Lake Superior is today. Then into the sky earth rocks by the hundreds of billions born of this collision exploded. They would reach a maximum vertical height of 400 miles and would land on the horizontal up to a thousand miles away. They would reach a speed when they fell back through the air cover of about 10,000 miles an hour and so would burn and ablate.

"But conditions were not ideal on that terrible day for all to burn and ablate because of the sand, dirt, gravel etc. that also was part of this fall, and so the burnt and unburnt lay side by side.

"THE TRUTH OF MY STORY are the rocks of Michigan's so-called 'glacial moraine' which cannot be influenced by prestige, money or diplomas. In one day, I can make a believer of any man if he be honest and wants truth in this science of geology.

"The mighty round craters on the moon (up to 150 miles across) would be Lake Superior, the Red Sea, and the depths of oceans on our earth when struck by planetoids, asteroids, comets, and meteorites.

"Our earth was born from what is out there, our earth gets struck by what is out there, and our earth will be from what is out there."
