### ORDINANCE NO. 24C ORDINANCE AMENDING WATER SUPPLY AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WATER SUPPLY AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FARMINGTON TO ADD A PART GOVERNING SEWER CONSTRUCTION AND THE RELATIONSHIP OF FARMINGTON ORDINANCES.

That Part V of the Water Supply and Sewage Disposal Ordinance, as amended, of the Township of Farmington, effective February 21, 1966, is amended as follows:

**PART V - WATER MAIN AND SEWER CONSTRUCTION**

No water main, sanitary or storm sewer which

shall serve or be designed to serve more than one premises shall be constructed or installed in the Township of Farmington unless a permit for such construction, reconstruction or alteration is issued by the Township Building Department.

Application for permit shall be accompanied by complete plans and specifications which shall be submitted to the Township Engineer for review and approval before such permit is issued. Such review will include:

a. Checking water main plans for site of mains and adequacy of gates and fire hydrants.

b. Checking sanitary and storm sewers to determine proper grade and resultant velocities.

c. Determining types of joints on the basis of the characteristics of the particular area.

d. Determining the proportion of pipe, 4th of trench and strength of pipe by depth of sewer and type of soil to be encountered.

e. Checking sizes to determine needs for sanitary sewers and run-off capacities for storm sewers.

f. Checking pavement designs for types of areas related to local soil conditions, adequacy of drainage and length of gutter runs between highpoints and catch basins and sidewalk crossings.

g. If the plans and specifications are approved by the Township Engineer, the construction permit shall be issued upon payment of the fees herein after provided. If the Township Engineer does not approve the plans and specifications he shall give his recommendations to the Township Clerk with a copy to the applicant. The applicant may amend the plans

5. A review and permit fee equal to 4% of one (1%) per cent of the estimated cost of the project determined by the Township Engineer shall be paid to the Township Treasurer at the time an application for permit is filed. An additional fee equal to three and one-half (3 1/2) per cent of the estimated cost of the project as determined by the Township Engineer shall be paid to the Township Treasurer at the time the permit is issued.

6. The amendatory ordinance shall be in effect immediately on publication in the Farmington Enterprise, Farmington, Michigan, Ordinance No. 29, FLOOR 2016.
