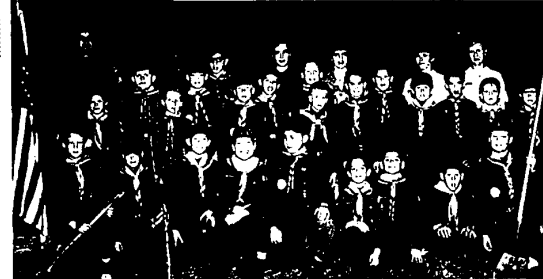
Course. For entertainment they will see a movie on golf etc. Now busy winding those clubs, the ladies are playing three games by May 1st that flies and averages can be compared.
