NUT BREAD, CUM LAUDE

3 cups Bisquick 1/4 cup sugar

Heat oven to 350°. Mix first four ingredients. Beat vigor-nolay 30 seconds. Stir in nuts. Pour into well-greased loaf pan, 92523 inches. Bake 45 to 50 minutes, or until wooden pick inserted in center come out clean. Cool before alicing.

Little Leaves: Prepare nut bread recipe except — divide batter among 8 well-greased ministure load pans, 4½/22/sety/ inches. Bake at 350° about 35 minutes. For round losves, divide batter among 5 well-greased soup cans. Bake at 350° about 40 minutes.
