### Township Board Proceedings

A Regular Meeting of the Farmington Township Board was called to order at 8:01 p.m. by Mr. Curt Hall, Chairman. Members present were: Hall, Avery, Nolen, Bessie, and Oppertbauer. Also present was Mr. Joseph T. Brennan, Township Attorney.

Minutes for Regular Meeting of May 23rd, 1966 stand approved as published.

Minutes for Special Meeting, Cost Estimates for sewer in Woodbrook Hills, stand approved as published.

MOTION by Duke, supported by Cairns, that all Building Permits be stopped until Woodbrook Hills Subdivision until such time as sanitary sewers are constructed, and that the County Health Department be so notified. Carried-unanimous.

MOTION by Duke, supported by Nolen, that the Township Board has declared its intention to proceed with preliminary engineering for sanitary sewer facilities in Woodbrook Subdivision, and hereby directs Pate, Hill & Bogue, Inc., to employ professional engineers, to prepare plans and an estimate of the cost thereof, and when prepared to present the same to this Board, 7 Year, 0 Nays.
