Farmington Players To Open With Shakespeare's Othello

The Farmington Players, ambitiously scheduling four major productions for the coming season plus two children's plays, will open their season with a fine version of "Othello." This Shakespearean tragedy was adapted for the Players by one of the members, Joseph Papp. It was done for a monthly workshop in June, and was met with such acclaim that the decision was made to add it to the regular season. "Othello" is directed by Nancy Harrower, who last directed "Come Blow Your Horn" for the Players. The major parts will be portrayed by Joe Papp, as "Othello", Richard-George Pedicini, as Iago, and Janice Salisbury as Desdemona. THIS IS AN IDEAL opportunity for high school students to see Shakespeare come alive on the stage, and many of the English and Speech teachers in the area schools feel it will be tremendously helpful as well as entertaining to their students. Adults also will enjoy becoming acquainted with Shakespeare, and this fast-moving, shortened version will be a treat for all who see it. THE PLAYERS' ENTIRE season promises to be stimulating and entertaining. Two children's productions will play the week-ends of Sept. 16 and 23, with a possibility of the 30th. The complete cast and dates of these two plays will be announced at a later date. After "Othello", the Barn will be dark until "Never Too Late," a delightful comedy which will open on Nov. 16, and play three week-ends. Feb. 17 will bring the powerful "Death of a Salesman" to the Players stage. All who saw the tremendous television presentation of the Arthur Miller play, will be doubly enthralled with the stage production. THE SEASON CLOSES with another bubbling comedy "A Shot in the Dark." This play will open on April 28, and all three will run for three week-ends.
