

# Gov. Romney Proclaims Space Week

Governor Romney has proclaimed the period of September 10 through September 18 as "Michigan Aviation and Space Week." It was announced by the Michigan Aeronautics and Space Association, sponsor of the event.

Thirteen major events make up "Aviation and Space Week," including more than twenty airport open house programs and a major "Air and Space Show" on the Willow Run Airport, September 17 and 18.

The Governor's proclamation reads as follows: "Our vast resources in Michigan... our knowledge of productivity and engineering skill... and our manpower... these factors have helped to make Michigan a large contributor toward the rapid advancement of our nation's civil aviation and space industry."

Research facilities in Michigan are in the forefront of developing new ideas, systems and products. Manufacturers supply essential hardware as electronic components and turn out complete products which are necessary in realizing the objectives set for this industry.

"So that Michigan citizens can be better informed of these achievements and the role aviation has played in Michigan, the Michigan Aeronautics and Space Association and the Michigan Aeronautics Commission will conduct a diversified week-long program to highlight these important accomplishments."
