In music, he participated in the Music Listening Program of Universalist Unitarian Church.

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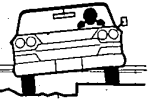
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What to do when... YOU RUN OFF THE PAVEMENT!

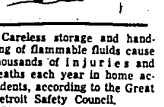


1. Grip wheel firmly

Careless storage and handling of flammable fluids cause thousands of injuries and deaths each year in home accidents, according to the Great Detroit Safety Council.

The council suggests flammable liquids be stored in galvanized steel fuel cans equipped with vapor-sealing caps. All fuel cans should be kept in the garage or tool shed—out of the house.

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
