## Cinarama To Benefit Women's ORT

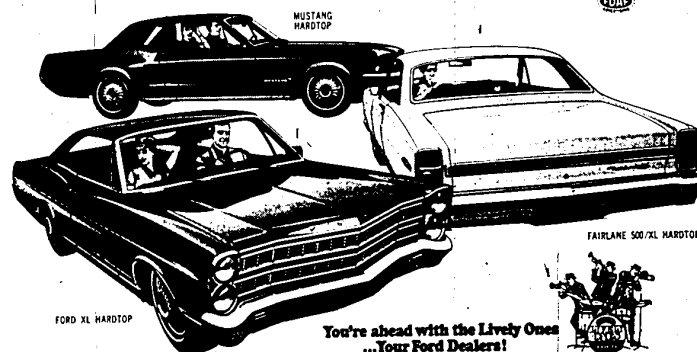
