Farmington Churches

Although he is far north from his birthplace in Gainesville, Tex., although he is an ordained pastor of the Southern Baptist Convention, the Rev. Billy Whitt of Forest Park Baptist Church, 27500 Shawnee, finds his northern pastorate "a challenge."

He says, "There are more problems serving a church here than in the south. For example, we have members from all the different states. Each has done things in a different way in his home church."

Conversely, the pastor says, "We don't try to emphasize the southern part of our national group. We're trying to break away from it. Someday, the name of the Southern Baptist Convention will be changed."

"However," he goes on, "My congregation is 40 percent northerners. The others came here when they were small children or were born here to parents who came from the south. We do not have many from the deep south."

The Southern Baptist Convention has 150 churches in Michigan. Pastor Whitt is moderator of the 15 it has in Oakland County.

The pastor became interested in his church's work in Michigan when he attended a revival meeting in 1963 at the First Baptist Church in Tontion. It was conducted by the Rev. Clarence Jones, a classmate of his at Southwestern Baptist Seminary in Fort Worth, Tex.

Pastor Whitt came to Forest Park Baptist in April, 1965, when there were about 40 church members. Today, the congregation numbers 250 with 288 children in the Sunday School.

His first services were conducted in what is now the parsonage, which adjoins the present new church. When the new edifice was occupied, the church's name was changed from Forest Park Baptist Church to Forest Park Baptist Church.

A native Michigan man, Clarence Walker, is superintendent of the Sunday School. Andy Roberts is church director of music and Mrs. Roberts director of the Junior choir.

Mrs. Ray Summan is president of the church's Women's Missionary Union and Neil McGee president of the men's Brotherhood.

All members of the church, including its pastor, pitched in to do odd jobs in building the new sanctuary. It is simple and contains in design with two bright spots of deep aqua in the carpeting and new seats.

Forest Park is Pastor Whitt's third church. He attended Decatur Baptist College, Decatur, Tex.; and Texas Wesleyan College in Fort Worth before entering the seminary and was ordained at the First Baptist Church of Muenster, Tex., which was his first pastorate.

He and his wife were married while they were both attending Decatur College and the pastor spent his remaining collegiate years working eight hours a night in an airplane factory while carrying a complete schedule of college classes.

The couple has three children, Jeffrey, 9, Billy Keith, 7, and Connie, 5, who all attend William Grace School just down the road from the parsonage.

A thoroughly articulate man, it is evident the pastor enjoys the preaching side of his clergyman's role. Although his church is fundamentalist in doctrine he often speaks from a topical text and has been known to spend 10 hours preparing for a 20 minute sermon.

When he mounts the pulpit he is equipped with notes but doesn't often refer to them except to check dates and statistics.

In casual discussion, he refuses to be baited on the subject of ecumenism, which the national body of his church does not support. He merely comments, "I don't believe we'll ever come to the place where we will all come together. We can have fellowship, but we'd have to compromise a lot on a fellowship of beliefs."

Pastor Whitt describes his church's belief this way: "The Bible is the inspired word of God. If we accept part of it we must accept it all because God is able to do all things."

He pondered accepting this doctrine after growing up in a Methodist home. After five years of indecision he became a Baptist.

He also has a fundamentalist's faith in life after death. On this he comments, "The Bible teaches us we 'look through a glass darkly.' Definitely there is a place we go to after death because the Lord said he would go and prepare a place and he would receive us. I have no fear of death because as a child of God I realize that when death comes it will be a gain."

"I have stood at many death beds and for the one who really had faith there was no fear."

He teaches the Christian who gives lip service to a church. "Joining a church will never allow a person to be saved. One must have a personal encounter with the Lord as the one he puts his faith and trust in. This faith that people put their trust in is what we teach to live and die by."

Take note of the current criticism on churches and their failure to meet life today. Pastor Whitt says, "It's hard for a person to get along with the Bible and meditate."

"But I think there is a lot that can be done on both sides. We're living in an hour when there is a big question mark that has been put beside God. I think many churches and also institutions of higher learning are raising the issue of today's problems."

These can be combated by a personal, daily living relationship with God. We've got to come back to the Bible; we've got to study the Bible more."

Judging from the scriptural references that are sprinkled throughout Pastor Whitt's conversation, his daily contact with the Bible is both simple and profound.
