AMENDMENT NO. 7 TO THE ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN

Section 1. That the territory lying within the City of Farmington, Oakland County, Michigan, described as: LOT 4 THRU 7, EXCEPTING THRU NORTH 115 FEET, EBENEZER STEWART'S PLAT, SECTION 27, T1N, R9E; be and the same is hereby zoned and shall hereafter be and constitute an R1P. Residential
