Population Survey To Be Conducted
A selected sample of households in this area will be asked questions about their employment during 1966 as part of the February Current Population Survey conducted by the U.S. Department of Commerce's Bureau of the Census, according to Robert A. Yerkey, Director of the Bureau's regional office in Detroit.
The 1966 employment survey will supplement questions on employment and unemployment asked each month by Bureau enumerators for the U.S. Department of Labor's Bureau of Labor Statistics.
The annual survey questions will be aimed at finding out the number of weeks worked during the year, the amount

of time lost because of unemployment and other reasons, and the principal job held during the year by each person in sample households.
All information given to Census interviewers will be kept confidential and may be used only for statistical purposes, Director Yerkey said.
