

Rev. Eddy To Moderate New Classes Offered By S'fld Church

With Ron Myers, a station regular, he will moderate the open-line telephone dialogue in which the Detroit station specializes. His segment will be the hours from four to 5 p.m.

Sunday's topic will cover civil liberties, the duty to dissent and the virtues of non-conformity.

Eddy, who prefers to dispense with any ministerial title, hopes that his time may be used creatively for "healthy" controversy on significant issues.

OLS Parish Subdivided Seven Times

When Msgr. Thomas P. Beahan came to Our Lady of Sorrows Catholic Church 23 years ago, he wasn't a monsignor, and the parish covered 65 miles.

The old church, which later became the parish hall, held 200 people if they crowded in.

The beautiful contemporary church is packed at masses each Sunday with the 1,500 present parish families.

Added to the usual parish business, Msgr. Beahan, at the direction of the archdiocese, is busy right now setting up the program for OLS's Project Communitarian program.

He attended Assumption College in Windsor and had no thoughts of becoming a priest when he enrolled. The decision was made over a two year period during which he became greatly impressed with the college's Basilian fathers.

Members of North Congregational Church Friday held a testimonial dinner honoring the Rev. and Mrs. Joseph G. Olin, who resigned as associate minister of the church as of April 1, after serving in this capacity for almost six years.

HE CAME TO Southfield from Manchester, N.H., where he had been minister at the South Main Street Congregational Church and was active in civic as well as church affairs. While in Southfield he has conducted bible classes for both adults and young people in the community and was instrumental in forming a Senior Men's Club which meets weekly at the church for recreation.

St. Alexander's of Farmington will present a spring dinner and fashion show at Glen Oaks Country Club on April 25, at 8 p.m.

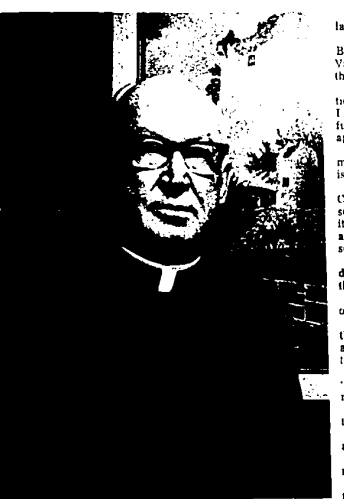

In 1961, Msgr. Beahan was made dean of the South Oak land Diocese, which includes 20 parishes.

While faced with the usual tasks of parish priests, Msgr. Beahan is well aware of new duties brought about by recent Vatican decrees. Some of these call upon the lay member of the church to assume greater responsibility for church affairs.

"There is greater participation by the people in the devotions of the church," he says. "As far as doctrine is concerned, I feel there are no essential changes, but there is a lot of confusion. Much study is still going on as to how these changes apply to the individual."

"All parishes are planning a series of meetings on these matters. It will be quite a task to educate the individual. There is still much work to be done at the diocesan level."

Asked about the apparent importance of the priest to the Catholic layman, Msgr. Beahan says, "There is a close association between the priest and his people. Oftentimes, I think it is because a Catholic with a problem feels a priest has the ability to help him or her to be able to obtain the services of someone who will be able to."

"As far as the church playing a part in the parishioner's daily life, I do think there are more social activities during the week in the Protestant church."

"With a great many of my people, it's simply a matter of going to mass on Sunday."

"But, on the other hand, the better Catholics do more for their church. I have some members with large families who are into all the church activities. One wonders where they get the time."

"But it's always been true of the Catholic," he goes on, "that if they are very good in the practice of their faith, they make better citizens and better leaders in the community."

DURING HIS 23-YEAR tenure at Our Lady of Sorrows, this veteran priest has seen seven parishes cut from it. They are St. Agatha's, St. Fabian's, St. Colman's, St. Alexander's, St. Priscilla's, St. Aidan's and St. Gerald's.

He thinks that Our Lady of Sorrows will spawn three more new parishes in the near future.

And he is well aware of the fuss that it will create among the members who are moved from Our Lady of Sorrows. Having gone through it seven times, he should be well prepared with the answers.
