Non-Medical Teams Being Considered

ANN ARBOR—Obstetricians and synecologists could cope with the increasing demands for their services if they would train non-physician associates to handle the routine care and education of pregnant women, according to Dr. J. Robert Willson of the University of Michigan Medical Center.

DR. WILLSON, chairman of the U-M Department of Ob-stetrics and Gynecology, said physicians should devote more stetrics and Gynecology, Said ophysicians should devote more time to premarital examinations, to patients with physical and emotional problems and it and emotional problems and it will be to be a superformed to be a superforme

"This would permit the physician to devote more time to women with complicated prenancies, those pregnant for the first time and to help more expectant mothers than he can at the present time."

pectain mothers than he can at the present time."
TRAINING programs to de-velop obstetric associates are now practically non-existen. Dr. Willson moted. But he urged that appropriate classes, be started in teaching hospi-tals where both doctors and nurses could participate in educating this new group of specialists.

He said the typical obstetri-cian today is strapped by time.
"Prenatal care for most pa-tients, particularly those who have aiready had one child without difficulty, often is li-tile more than a series of soil tile more than a series of soil visits with the doctor. Yet they prevent the obstetrician from seeing other women who may be encountering serious prob-lems."

DR. WILLSON noted that too few doctors do adequate pre-martial examinations nor take this opportunity to counsel their patients on family plan-ning and the other problems of family life.
