The art show is scheduled for Saturday, April 22, from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Sunday, April 23, from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. Refreshments will be served. Mrs. Elaine Ford, 32355 Leeland Road, who associated as a volunteer with the hospital during the fall of 1964 and who was appointed as a member of the hospital's Activity Therapy Department in September of 1966, is the staff sponsor. During the past several months, members of the hospital's Patients' Council have been working with Mrs. Ford in the preparation of a revolving display of paintings in the hospital cafeteria. Many of these will be included in the exhibit.

"The art work that will be displayed," commented Mrs. Ford, "represents the efforts of patients throughout our hospital. We know that many visitors will be interested in the fine work that some of our patients, without formal instruction, have been able to accomplish."

## Prince Of Peace To Hear Pastor From Inner City

The Rev. David Eberhard, pastor of Riverside Lutheran Church, Detroit, will be the guest speaker at Prince of Peace Lutheran Church, 12 Mile and Farmington Road, on Thursday evening, April 27 at 8 p.m. The Women's League is presenting Pastor Eberhard and one or two inner-city "Peace Corps" workers as part of their April program. Pastor Eberhard ministers to an inner-city congregation on the lower east side of Detroit. Various newspapers and magazine articles have acclaimed his ministry as "Peace Corps" workers as part of their April program.

He has taken a handful of people and built them into a creative congregation of 300 and the parish has been expanded to include an Inner-City Community Clinic, Lutheran Peace Corps workers, a welfare center for clothing and food, and many other services. The clinic itself uses 80 different volunteers a month and last year served about 6000 persons in its social service, legal, psychiatric and counseling divisions.

Any person interested in attending is cordially invited to do so. A free will offering will be collected to be given to Riverside Church fund and canned goods donations will be made to the welfare center.
