ALFALFA FOR POULTRY YARDS GATE MADE TO WORK EASILY

Food for Chickens—Crowns Are Hard to Kili Dut.

(By PHILO K. BLINN, Colorade Experiment Station.)

Alfalfa is one of the best plants to furnish green food for chickens, but ordinarily it soon kills out if over pastured.

Alfalfa rowns that have been cut off and plowed under, and that have the content of the color taken root again, are much harder to kill out, as rabbing out the sain stool that has taken root the second time. Such crowna seem to put out shoots from each piece of root that is left in the ground, if the soil is in favorable condition.

Those who desire to establish alfalfa in their poultry yards can succeed in this way by plowing or spading under alfalfa crowns that have been near by. Early in the spring is the best time, while the crowns are still dormant. The crowns should be covered four to six inches deep, and the soil wet down and kept moist, and the chickens kept off until the crowns have become established, which will be much sooner than by alfalfa seeding, and will stand much harder pasture.
