Pilgrim Townhouses Opened in Plymouth

The Plymouth Construction Co., a joint enterprise of Edward Rose and Sons, Inc. and Mark Jacobson Builders, Inc., announce the opening of Pilgrim Townhouses and Manor Houses in Plymouth. Pilgrim Townhouses mark a departure from traditional construction under the government's 221 D3 Housing Program.

For the first time in Michigan, and probably in the nation, garden-type apartments, called Manor Houses, are being offered under the 221 D3 program. This is a small community of just 104 homes. The juxtaposition of garden-type apartments and townhouses makes the site exceptionally visually pleasing.

A second unusual feature of both the Townhouses and Manor Houses is that utilities, except electricity, are metered and the charge is included in the monthly payment.

The Manor House payment of \$119 per month includes gas for heating, heating water, cooking and water.

Each Manor House building will have eight 2-bedroom, 1-bath manor house apartments. Each individual apartment will be on one floor and will include a convenient utility room. Two-bedroom and 3-bedroom townhouses are also being offered. Each townhouse, a two-story structure has a full basement and 1 1/2 baths.

Both the Manor Houses and Townhouses have a luxurious kitchen with built-in oven, range and disposer, a 12 cu. ft. hotpoint refrigerator and handsome custom kitchen cabinets.

The baths have a vanity top with a large mirror and ceramic tile. The rooms are spacious and there is abundant closet space. The exterior
