More than 400 Blue Lodge Masons from 11 southeastern Michigan counties received the 32nd Degree in Scottish Rite of Freemasonry over the weekend at the main Masonic Temple in Detroit.

The 60th semi-annual reunion honored K. T. Keller, former president and Board Chairman of the Chrysler Corporation. Mr. Keller, a 33rd Degree Mason, died suddenly while visiting London, England, last January. The 19,000 members of Detroit Scottish Rite reside in Branch, Hillsdale, Jackson, Lenawee, Livingston, Macomb, Monroe, Oakland, St. Clair, Washtenaw and Wayne counties. Clyde A. Fulton, also a 33rd Degree Mason, and prominent Charlotte attorney and titular head of Scottish Rite in Michigan was the principal speaker at the 32nd Degree banquet, attended by more than 1,500 Masons Saturday evening.

His subject, "Let There Be Light," spoke of the personal, moral and patriotic obligation of all Americans.

Toastmaster was Circuit Court Judge John M. Wiley, also a 33rd Degree Mason, and William N. Montgomery, Detroit. William Rite is a part of the \$64,000 member Northern Masonic Jurisdiction.
