

Santa to Arrive at Mall Friday

Merry Old Santa Claus will arrive at the Livonia Mall Shopping Center, Friday at 1:30 p.m. sharp, according to executives of the Livonia Mall Merchant's Association.

Santa will arrive at the Shopping Center in his sleigh and will tour the parking lot before going to his workshop and huge sled which awaits him in the enclosed mall.

Children wishing to see and talk to Santa will be welcome aboard his 24 foot sled drawn by nine reindeer.

Santa's workshop will be alive with activity as his little elves make the thousands of toys Santa will need for his trip through the sky on Christmas Eve. Children will be allowed to go through the workshop before saying hello to Santa.

The enclosed Livonia Mall will be a veritable Christmas Wonderland this year with its main mall bedecked in traditional green garland entwined with multi-color

miniature lights. The two huge Christmas trees in the Sears and Crowley courts will highlight the mall decor. A three dimensional Nativity scene complete with live animals will be installed two weeks before Christmas in the Sears court. Local choral groups will sing at the Nativity scene beginning Dec. 21.

Santa's sled and workshop is located in the Crowley Mall and Santa will be at home from 10 a.m. 'til 9 p.m. every night until Christmas.

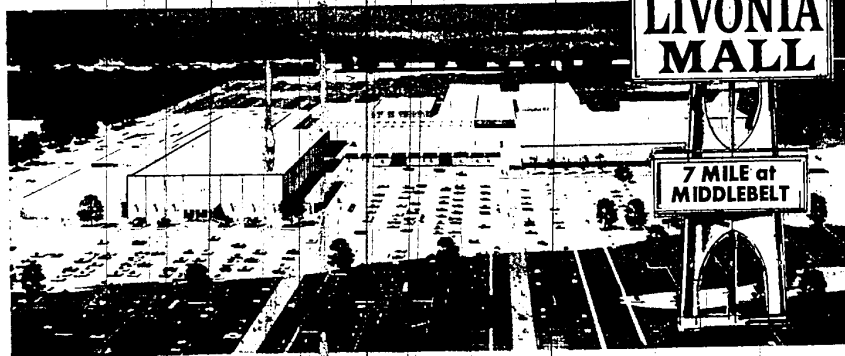
SANTA ARRIVES AT THE MALL FRIDAY
