Offer Tips For Cooking Wild Game

Hunters often give game away because their guests feel they don't know how to cook it. June L. Sears, Wayne county Extension Home Economist says.

Men hunt mainly for sport, and not for meat. However, game can provide good eating when properly cooked and prepared. Game shot and not eaten may also be due to the family believing that the game is not good to eat.

"Good Eating from Woods and Fields" is the title of a revised booklet available from the Cooperative Extension Service. The home economist points out that needed information on preparation and cooking techniques are contained in the bulletin.

The best methods of preparing pheasant, wild duck and geese, rabbits, grouse, woodcock and partridges are discussed in detail. Several recipes from all parts of the country are given for each game species. Mrs. Sears points out.

Recipes and methods of preparation for more uncommon game species such as beaver, woodchuck (ever try a woodchuck meat pie?), opossum and raccoon are listed. A bulletin will be a handy addition to any hunting cabin, as well as the hunter's home.

The bulletins are available at a charge of 10 cents from the Wayne County Extension Office, located at 3930 Newberry Street in Wayne, or from the Bulletin Office, Cooperative Extension Service, Agriculture Hall, Michigan State University, East Lansing 48823.

Clean Before Storing
 Be sure out-of-season clothing is clean before putting it in garment bag or cedar chest. Dirt, acids and chemicals change with time and can cause permanent damage to stored fabrics.

It's Corn Meal Treat Time

Old Southern cooks who spent their days in the kitchen used to be the only ones who held the secret of corn bread. Now the busiest homemaker can bake homemade corn meal muffins, corn bread and even corn fritters in the time it takes to set the table and call the family to dinner.

Prepare corn meal batter from self-raising corn meal, refrigerate it then bake it... up to three days later. The leavening action is held in check until the instant the batter meets the action of the oven or skillet.

The new leavening agent, a product of the Monsanto Company, is the modern baking secret. Hush puppies for dinner? Pancakes or hoe cakes? With prepared batter in the refrigerator, they are quick, easy and just as delectable as the Old Southern cooks used to make.

CORN STICKS OR CORN MUFFINS
 1 1/2 cups self-rising corn meal mix or self-rising corn meal
 1 1/4 cups milk
 1 egg
 2 tablespoons melted butter, shortening, or cooking oil

Sugar may be added to taste. Generally grease 12 corn stick molds or muffin tins and place in oven while preheating to 450°. Mix milk, egg and butter in a two-quart bowl. Add self-rising corn meal mix and blend until smooth.

Pour batter into a closable pitcher or other container for use and storage. The batter can be kept in this type of container and stored in the refrigerator for up to three days. This simplifies the preparation of delicious corn sticks over busy weekends and during last minute dinner planning.

Fill the preheated molds or tins approximately 3/4 full with fresh or stored batter. Bake 15 to 20 minutes at 450° or until a golden crust forms. Serve hot with plenty of butter and stand back!
