The Teenage Committee of Northwest Branch has come to the conclusion that Junior High School level is the ideal time to establish an understanding between mother and daughter. Although many parents feel their girls are not yet faced with these concerns at this age a mutual understanding at this time will help alleviate tensions as issues arise.
