

Livonia Mall Opens Medical- Dental Center

The Livonia Mall Shopping Center located at Seven Mile and Middlebelt Roads has recently opened a modern two-story Medical-Dental Center in the huge shopping complex.

Included in the original planning, the Medical-Dental Center portion of the 750,000 square foot giant shopping center, was the last area to be completed.

"We were extremely selective in acquiring what we consider the finest doctors in their respective fields, that were available in the Detroit area, consequently it wasn't until late last fall that we were ready to open the Medical-Dental Center," Robert Poris, general manager of the Mall explained.

The Medical-Dental Center is located in the West Mall area near the Twin Cinema Theatre and is entered from within the enclosed Mall. It has two levels and houses four separate suites, three of which already are occupied.

Dr. Milton Kellman, physician-surgeon, and general practitioner, and Dr. Arthur M. Stern, foot specialist, have offices on the ground floor. Dr. Bernard D. Lynn, A.B., D.D.S., has his dental offices on the second floor of the unique structure.

Dr. Kellman has been in practice in the Wayne Coun-

ty area since 1950. His office is completely equipped to handle any general medical patient. He specializes in general family practice and has been active in research on the treatment of basititis. He recently has had an article concerning this research published in a nationally known journal.

Dr. Kellman, active in civic affairs, was the Director of United Foundation's North Livonia division in 1965 and Director of Western Wayne County Zone in 1966. Since 1964, he has been the official physician in residence at the Detroit Race Course.

Dr. Lynn is a graduate of Mt. Clemens High School and was graduated from the University of Michigan in 1930 with the degree of Bachelor of Arts. He enrolled in the University of Detroit, School of Dentistry in 1933, and was graduated with the degree of Doctor of Dental Surgery in 1936.

Dr. Lynn has been in the practice of Dentistry for 30 years. He served in the Army Dental Corps and while stationed in the European Theatre of Operations, wrote that portion of the manual which dealt with the identification of the bodies of the American soldiers by their teeth.

In professional life, Dr. Lynn has had published many scientific articles and has lectured throughout the United States on State and National levels.

Dr. Lynn is a member of the Detroit District Dental Society, Michigan State Dental Association, American Dental Association, Pediatric Fauchard Academy, Academy of General Dentistry, Founder and First President of the Michigan Society of Psychosomatic Dentistry, and the Federation Dentaire Internationale. He is also a member of Perfection Lodge No. 486 F and AM and is active in the Boy Scouts.

Dr. Stern, foot specialist, has been in practice over 20 years in the Metropolitan Detroit area. He specializes in surgical podiatry and all phases of orthopedic work.

His modern clinic is thoroughly equipped to handle all foot problems. He is a member of the National as well as Michigan State Podiatry Association and has had two articles published in the Podiatry Journal.

Dr. Stern is on the staff and Board of Directors of Civic Hospital. A Past Master of the Matonic Lodge, he is also active in the Old Newsboys Goodwill Association.

3 From College at Meeting

Schoolcraft College President Eric J. Bradner, and Harold E. Fischer, Plymouth, chairman of the college Board of Trustees, and Mrs. Jane K. Moehle, Plymouth, board vice-chairman, attended the fourth annual Community College Trustee-Presidents Conference at Jefferson City, Mo., Jan. 29-31.

Dr. Bradner and Fischer were among the program speakers during the three-day conference sponsored by the Midwest Community College Leadership Program in cooperation with the University of Michigan Extension Service. The leadership program is supported in part by a grant from the W.K. Kellogg Foundation.

Dr. Bradner spoke on "The Role of the Community College President," at a Thursday morning session (Jan. 26) and was one of two consultants at a seminar for college administrators Thursday afternoon.

Fischer, who is president of the recently organized Michigan Assn. of Community College Boards, discussed the role and function of that organization at a general meeting Thursday afternoon. The conference, attended by administrators and trustees of two-year colleges throughout the midwest, is one of two being sponsored by the leadership program during the early part of 1967. A second meeting is scheduled for Albuquerque, N. M., talk in March.
