Bit of Paint Adds Joy To Old Wornout Toys

Does your child cherish a toy that has become worn? A new coat of paint may be all that's needed to brighten up this toy and turn it into a bright new treasure. You can stretch your child's Christmas for many months by simply painting those wagons, tricycles, dollhouses, and other playthings that have begun to rust or chip.

Painting is easy and fun, and so much more economical than replacing toys. These tips from the National Paint, Varnish and Lacquer Association will help make your job easier.

First, you should decide on the type of paint to use for your project. Of course, you'll want to choose bright, gay colors, but you must be careful that the coatings you use contain no ingredients that would be harmful if chewed or swallowed by young children.

In fact, if a paint contains even small amounts of lead, antimony, arsenic, cadmium, mercury, selenium or soluble barium it is not advisable to use it on children's toys.

Have your reputable paint dealer check the label of the paint you are purchasing to assure its safety. Quality paints will give best results—and always read the label directions carefully before starting to paint.

You'll want to use brushes of proper sizes for each project. Round and flat sash brushes are often used, and small artists brushes are helpful when working on small toys.

If the top has any cracks, dents, or nail-head indentations you'll need to use some type of filler or spackling compound. You may find that a filler in tube form will be the handiest since you can squeeze out just the right amount as needed.

Any wooden surfaces should be sanded before painting. Then, go right ahead with the application of your color. Just remember to avoid dipping your brush into the paint more than one-third of its bristle length. Always start on an unpainted area and work toward a painted one when you have just refilled your brush.

When working with metal that has rusted, you can use either coarse sandpaper or steel wool to remove the corrosion. After the rust is removed, be sure to use a special rust-inhibiting primer on the bare metal. For a final coat, use a hard-drying durable enamel.

Handy, easy-to-use cans of aerosol paints may further simplify your task. They can also be used to create new designs by using stencils or to add a gay stripe by spraying over masking tape.

Your youngster will be even more pleased with his "new looking" toys if you personalize them by stenciling his name or initials on the top or side.

In most instances, hardboard siding can be installed right over the old siding. This provides extra insulation and saves the trouble and expense of removing old boards.

Another asset of hardboard is its low-maintenance quality. Because it is an engineered wood product, the surface is free of knots or rough grain and takes a paint or stain
