The City of Livonia in cooperation with The Observer Newspaper Group is planning a seminar on air and water pollution and the third pollution, solid waste.

The day-long program will take place Saturday, March 4 at Stevenson High School. Registration will be from 9 to 9:30 and the program will last until approximately 4 p.m. Civic leaders from surrounding communities have been invited.

The luncheon speaker will be Ron Linton, chairman of Task Force on Environmental Health and Related Problems from Washington, D.C. He will bring with him Gary Frink, an associate to answer questions.

SS Office Has Medicare Forms For Elderly

Sam F. Test, Manager of the Detroit-Northwest Social Security office, said he has recently learned some Medicare beneficiaries find they need help completing the medical insurance claim forms. His form, called SSA 1480, is used for requesting payment after the beneficiary has received medical services of \$50 or over in a calendar year. The form appears on page 29 of the Medicare Handbook which has been sent to each Medicare beneficiary. The form may also be obtained at any Social Security office and at most doctor's offices.

Test said, "if anyone who is filling out this form for the first time needs help with it, he may visit or phone the Social Security office. The people there will be glad to answer your questions."

An incomplete or incorrectly filled out form may cause payment to be delayed.

The Detroit-Northwest office is located at 18500 Grand River. The office is open Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. On Wednesday, the office is open until 7:30 p.m.

Jones is the author of Livonia's 1963 Master Sanitary Sewer Program and "A Financial Study of Clean Landfill Requirement and Incinerator Construction Program." The study is considered by experts in the field to be the most comprehensive report to date on the solid waste problem. He is a member of the American Public Works Association and the Institute of Solid Waste.

Sharing the morning program will be Morton Sterling talking on "Air Pollution in the Jet Age."

Sterling serves on a myriad of commissions in connection with his job as chief, Air Pollution Control Section, Wayne County Health Department. In addition he is a non-resident lecturer for U of M school of Public Health and Wayne State U. Department of Industrial Medicine.

He is a graduate of Polytechnic Institute of Brooklyn and graduate studies in Advanced Thermodynamics and Power Generation.

John S. Stock will also be on the morning program talking on better environmental health and clean water.

Following luncheon there will be an afternoon session encompassing the industrial side of the picture.

Bob Bird of Centri-Spray will talk on "Industrial Science and Air and Water Pollution." Robert Stellwagen will talk of the use of the air scrubber and incinerator. Fred Kellow will report on the progress in State programs of solid waste disposal.

The sponsors hope to inform the invited members of various governments on the problems facing the area in the coming years—and suggestions for legislation they can support to solve the problem that threatens the health and welfare of all the citizens of the State of Michigan.

Engineers and other interested residents may attend the seminar and register the day of the program.

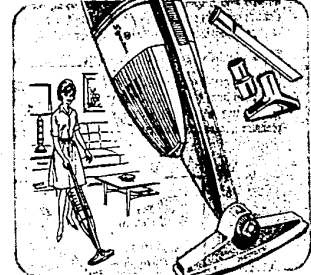

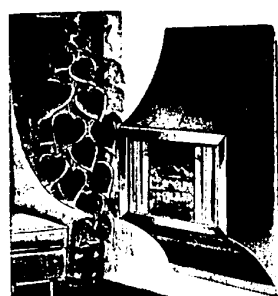
