"Discounting is neither new nor unique in appliance retailing," says Derm Rowland of Home Appliance Mart. "It's probably safe to assume every appliance dealer is a discounteer—at least to some degree. How much any specific dealer discounts is determined by his purchasing power, volume of business, and of course, his own policies of operation."

"Home Appliance Mart (at Plymouth and Wayne Roads, Livonia) was planned from the beginning as a discount operation and was one of the first in Michigan to retail on this basis. As our volume has increased, so has our purchasing power."

"At this point it is doubtful that anybody has an advantage over us in this respect, or in the brand names we carry. As for our policies on discounting, all I can say is we do not intend to lose a single sale over price."

"There is more to our business policies than just having low discount prices, however. Not everybody is interested in just the lowest prices."

"For this reason we have made every effort to offer bigger selections, more brand names, courteous well trained sales help and our own efficient up to date service department."

Kindergarten Registration Starts Tuesday

It's kindergarten round-up time again in Garden City and for the first time since 1961 there is expected to be an increase in their numbers entering school next fall.

Starting in 1952, and for 10 consecutive years, kindergarten enrollment increased from 410 to 1,332 in 1961-62.

Each year since then it has declined slightly, as home-building tapered off.

Now, with the influx of new families coming into the Cherry Point subdivision, and other new homes in the city, the projected kindergarten enrollment next fall is 1,360, compared to the 1,304 counted last September.

Each March, to better acquaint parents with the nature and purpose of the kindergarten program, the elementary schools conduct a series of round-ups.

They run this year from next Tuesday, March 7, through March 23.

Dog Licenses Due March 1, Chief Warns

Westland dog owners were reminded by Police Chief Garrison Clayton last week that the license renewal deadline is today (Wednesday).

The chief also cautioned residents that not only must all dogs be licensed, but must be on a leash. Failure to do this "is a common violation which is very distasteful to many neighbors and our efforts will be extended toward correcting this," Clayton said.

Licenses may be bought at the City Clerk's office in the Westland City Hall from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. during the week and until 8 p.m. on Tuesday. Before the March 1 deadline, the cost is \$2 for females and \$1 for males or unsexed dogs. After March 1, the cost doubles.

"All dogs over two months old must have a license. A certificate indicating rabies vaccine shots must be presented at the time of buying the license for all dogs over six months old," Clayton said.

Licenses help in the recovery of a lost or stolen dog, the chief also said.

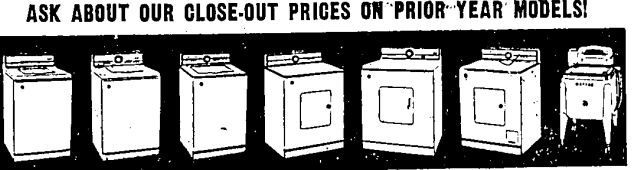
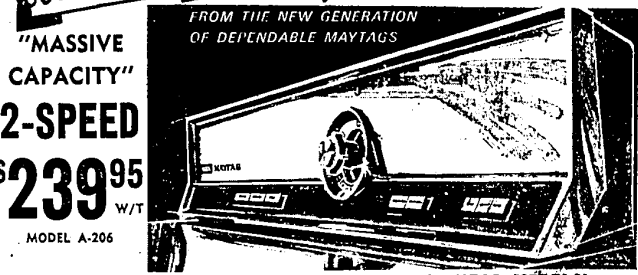
