He is flexible in his delivery and material. He has an uncanny sense of timing, a fine singing voice that backs up his jokes, impressions and characterizations. The fun he makes of TV is an act of perfection.

Lennon will share the lime light with Joanie Whittman, comedienne, singer and dancer, and the Lonnie Schick Trio. They are filling in for vacationing Sassy Sylvia and Harry Harris who return to the club on Monday, March 13.

US Singletons To Organize Area Chapter
