

Schoolcraft Slates Poet, Opera, Film

A poet, two operas and a film of the college district during the first two weeks of March. The schedule of the campus creative arts series calls for a visit today

(Wednesday) of Poet John Haines; performances of Mozart's "The Impresario" and Menotti's "The Telephone" by the Pico-Lo Opera Company on Friday, March 10; and two showings of the Guinness film "Kind Hearts and Coronets" on Friday, March 17.

Of Haines' work, one publication recently said, "To read him is a fresh and deeply moving experience." A homesteader in Alaska, Haines lives in a house he built himself and earns his livelihood raising vegetables, picking berries, hunting, fishing and trapping.

His poems reflect his life on the edge of the wilderness.

He will make two appearances on the campus. The first at 3 p.m. will be in the lower level of the Waterman Center, the second at 8 p.m. in the library.

Detroit's Pico-Lo Opera Company will be on campus Friday evening, March 10, for a twin bill of one-act operas starting at 8:15 p.m. in the Waterman Center.

The company features Marjorie Gordon, Marilyn Colow, Robert Angus, Warren Rich, and Bernard Katz. Mozart's "Impresario" is a tuneful comedy of two rival prima donnas who embarrass and exasperate a struggling impresario and threaten the existence of his opera company. A stage-struck banker rescues the company and brings peace between the singers.

Menotti's "Telephone" has become part of the standard contemporary opera repertoire. A satirical comic opera it pokes fun at all of us who use Mr. Bell's invention.

"Kind Hearts and Coronets," the film which established the reputation of Alec Guinness, will be shown at 2 p.m. and 8 p.m. Friday, March 17.

A hilariously funny murder story, the plot involves Guinness as eight different characters, each of whom is murdered in a unique way.

Dennis Price, Valerie Hobson and Joan Greenwood share acting honors with Guinness.

Concert Will Feature Strings
