

Start New Rubbish Schedule

A new schedule for residential refuse pickup in the City of Plymouth went into effect Monday. The purpose, according to DPW Supt. Kenneth Vogras, is to provide residents with more efficient service on a four-day basis instead of five as in the past. Collections will start at 7 a.m. Vogras recommends that containers be properly located for pickup the evening before the scheduled collection to insure that none are missed.

The new daily routes are as follows: Monday — that area bounded by the C&O Railroad, Penniman Ave. and Main Street; Tuesday — that section south of the C&O Railroad to Mill Street; Wednesday — the district bounded by Main Street, C&O Railroad, Mill Street and Ann Arbor Road; Thursday — the area bounded by Sheldon Rd., Penniman Ave., Main Street and Ann Arbor Road.

Vogras emphasizes that full cooperation of all is needed in following the regulations set forth in City Ordinance No. 194. Copies of the ordinance and the boundaries for each of the four collection days were mailed to every resident late last week.

Franklin Student Attends MS Awards Banquet

Thomas Bates, of Franklin High, is among the select group of high school students throughout the state who have been invited to attend the Awards Banquet at Michigan State University on Saturday, March 11.

The students will be honored for outstanding performances in the 10th Michigan Mathematics Prize Competition.

More than 26,000 students from 600 high schools throughout the state participated. Those invited to the banquet are the top 97 winners.

The competition was started in 1958 to stimulate greater interest in high school mathematics. It is an activity of the Michigan Section of the Mathematical Association of America and is sponsored by Michigan's colleges, professional organizations and industries.

This year \$5,000 in scholarship prizes will be awarded. The Gold Medal and Silver Medal awards and the individual scholarship awards will be announced at the banquet.

During the past week Department of Public Works crews cold patched all local and major streets where needed. Work was continued on tearing down and burning the old garage at Riverside Cemetery. Two funerals took place last week.

More than 45 tons of salt were used to clear streets of the snow. The sanitary sewer on Fralick Street was unplugged and a new sanitary sewer manhole installed on Forest Avenue between Wing and Linden Streets.

A pump was pulled for repairs at the Six Mile Well station and replaced after the repair work was completed. During the time the pump was out of operation, it was necessary to manually operate the equipment with men on duty around the clock.
