# Burroughs Introduces New Two-Way Computer

A new Burroughs information entry and visual display system to provide instant two-way communication with a computer has been announced by Ray W. Macdonald, Burroughs Corporation President.

The Burroughs Input and Display System makes the processing power and memory of a computer available to offices and working areas located away from the computer by means of direct communication.

Through the unique capabilities of the new Burroughs system, the operator can enter information directly into the computer, update or alter information stored in computer memory, call out information from the computer, or project information on a display screen and modify computer programs.

The system is available in two models. One is a self-contained model with a single display/keyboard and control unit. The control unit contains the power supply and memory logic of the system. The second model has a central control unit and up to four separate display/keyboard units.

Resembling the combination of a television picture tube and a typewriter keyboard, the system has a 9x13 inch screen and can display 25 lines of data. Up to 80 characters of information, or the maximum amount of data recorded in a single punched card, can be displayed on each line of the screen.

Through the keyboard, the operator can make direct entries to the computer or changes in information stored in memory. As a result, the extra operation of keypunching and verifying of keypunched information can be eliminated for the information being entered.

"Applications for the Burroughs Input and Display System are virtually unlimited. Display/keyboard units

may be used for every existing phase of data recording, computations and information exchange in business and finance.

"Equally suited to a multitude of applications in other fields, the system also can be used in medicine, research, engineering, law enforcement, education and government. Key punching and verifying and other time-consuming data input processes can be substantially reduced in many applications and the new Burroughs system," said Macdonald.

## A Tip on Moving Moving? Discard All Useless Items First

You can reduce much of the physical and mental strain of the move to your new home or apartment by dividing the work into separate stages and allowing yourself time to carry out your plan smoothly.

Before you list a single piece of furniture, make lists of those items that are to be thrown out, those which you want to sell or give away and those which have to be packed.

First, make arrangements with trash collectors to remove the items to be thrown out on a specific date.

If there are many such items and they are bulky or heavy, it may pay to hire someone to give you a hand or to seek the aid of good friends and neighbors. Next, contact local furniture dealers or other prospective buyers and have them come over to inspect and make offers on the items you wish to sell.

Once you have agreed on price, make immediate arrangements for the buyers to come and cart away their property. Or if you wish to donate certain items, consider calling The Salvation Army or other charities who come and pick them up. Such donations are deductible from your income tax.

## Tree Growing Requirement Is Know-How

Take a good look at your woodlot this winter. Do mature trees dominate certain areas, preventing the growth of saplings beneath?

Can more desirable tree species be planted in some areas? Are shrubs and grasses needed for wildlife cover and food?

According to a Pennsylvania State University correspondence course in woodlot forestry, good management requires that trees grow close together.

Competition for space and light causes trees to crowd their tops as they grow making long, straight trunks free of side branches. Long boards, clear of knots, are cut from such logs.

But, there may be too many trees in an area. Overcrowding results in spindly-stemmed trees. Thin the stand by cutting out trees of low value.

To learn management of woodlots study Penn State's correspondence course. Eight lessons cover reforestation, planning cover and food bearing plants for wildlife, selecting trees for cutting, estimating volume and value of standing timber as well as general management of woodlots.
