

Questers Hear About Colonial Williamsburg

The charm of "Colonial Williamsburg, Virginia" was brought in a talk to the Questerdom Questers by Mrs. Fred Harrison at the home of Mrs. R. J. Truesdell, 29546 Briarcliff, Farmington, recently.

Mrs. Harrison said that this village dates back to 1729 and that the 18th century buildings, furnishings and gardens take their original form in this significant community. Trim carriages roll along Duke of Gloucester Street, their main public way, and described by the late President Roosevelt as "the most historic avenue in all America."

Colored slides were also shown of the weather board-ed houses of colonial days; the wealth of handsome English and American furnishings in the buildings which are open to the public. Efforts in this restoration work are not only to exhibit evidence of the past, but also to recreate a living community.

In 1926 decay threatened to destroy what remained of the colonial capital until John D. Rockefeller, Jr. gave his support to its restoration. The work has been carried out by Colonial Williamsburg, Inc., dedicated to the purpose "That the Future May Learn From the Past." This specialty is the feeling one gets when walking along the roads and gardens where, too, George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Patrick Henry, George Wythe and other leaders lived and made history.

There are several historical buildings that are considered a "must": the Governor's Palace; the Capitol Building, where the laws of the colony were enacted; the Public Gaol; and the George Wythe House; the Courthouse of 1770.

To appease the appetites, there are various taverns: the Chowning's Tavern, served by waiters in colonial costumes; the King's Arms Tavern, where the waiters are all students of William and Mary College and, who too, are costumed in the manner of their colonial forebears.

One of the most inspiring places Mrs. Harrison visited, was the Bruton Parish Church, where George Washington, Thomas Jefferson and others worshipped for many years. You may kneel down

on the individual kneelers and be reminded of the part religion played in the daily life of 18th Century Virginia.

Today Williamsburg stands as a symbol of one of the most impressive eras of the American past.

The next meeting will be held March 22 at the home of Mrs. William J. Conroy, who will give a talk on "Early Woodenware."
