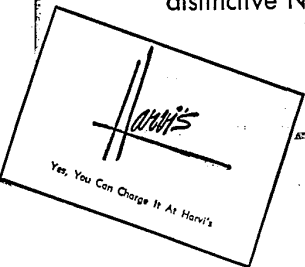

Benefits OK'd For Employees

The Peoples Community Hospital Authority's Board of Directors recently approved a half-million dollar package of new salary increases and fringe benefits for its employees.

If the \$503,400 figure is included in the proposed budget for the fiscal year to start next July 1, the board would have to consider a \$3 per day raise in room rates at the PCHA's four unit hospital.

If the day rate is increased this summer, it would be the fourth rate hike within the past year. At present the room rate is \$32 per day.

The estimated cost of the salary schedule improvements, effective July 1, would be \$225,700 with the actual increases to run another \$165,000.

Also in the package is a \$68,200 figure for a retirement program for salaried employees.

There is also a retirement program which carries a \$27,700 cost. This plan has employees contributing 1.5 per cent of their earnings over \$6,600 per year.

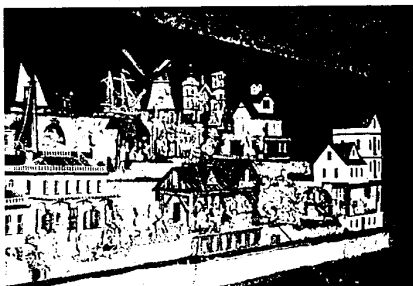

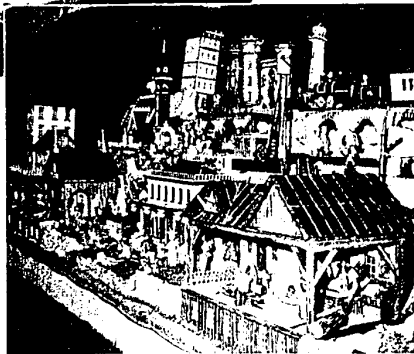
