Search Goes on for Buried \$1,000 Check

Livonia has seen promotion before—new gimmicks are not unusual—but seldom has a promotion had as much response and been as interesting as the Wonderland Merchants buried check.

Well over 3,000 area residents are combing Livonia's 36 square miles in search of the \$1,000 check buried by Wonderland Center.

The search, launched March 29, has attracted widespread attention throughout the Detroit metropolitan area.

More than 30,000 calls have been received on three telephones equipped with automatic answering devices. The telephones register each call.

Inquiries have been received from such distant points as St. Clair Shores and Wyandotte. A Roy at Oak family spent most of Sunday afternoon digging in Livonia.

The unsigned check was secretly buried on vacant land near a Livonia landmark. As the *Observer* Newspapers want to press it had not been unearthed.

Once the jigsaw puzzle map is assembled searchers must call for mystery clues. New clues are made available daily at 8:30 a.m. Each new clue leads the diggers closer to the hidden cache.

A Livonia police officer has obtained a military mine-detecting aid to his search during off-duty hours.

Road Toll Lower In State

Michigan traffic deaths in March numbered 125, a reduction of 54 or 30 per cent from the all-time record of 179 set for that month last year, according to State Police provisional figures.



It was the fourth month in a row to show decreased deaths compared with corresponding months a year earlier. The March average for the last five years, 1962-66, was 142.

The number of deaths in March brought the state's first quarter traffic toll to 352, which was a reduction of 129 or 27 per cent compared with 481 in the same period last year.

Delayed death reports will raise the provisional totals somewhat.
