ordinator will account for another \$13,500 reduction in salary, supplies and printing. This office became vacant with the recent resignation of Mrs. Marjorie Elcher and a replacement will not be sought.

Transportation cuts will be realized in the amount of \$13,500 even though nine new buses will be added. This will be accomplished by financing the balance of the cost \$14,200, cash payment of \$18,275. Ordinarily, the district pays cash for the year's quota of five buses.

Maintenance budget costs will be reduced by \$83,562. Curtailed services in the area of landscaping, parking lots and roofing will account for \$17,500 of this amount and another \$26,162 will be saved when \$14 takes over formerly contracted services of roofing and painting.

It is estimated that another \$10,000 in interest payments on short term notes may be eliminated. Placed in the original budget when the state treasurer said that no advances on state aid will be available next year, this item may be deleted by delaying payment on some invoices until local taxes are available.

retaining trained personnel," he notes.

Over all, the public safety pay increases amount to 10 per cent. Pay scales in other departments were raised 5 to 8 per cent.

"Expanded services have been provided for the newly annexed area, which includes a 12 inch transmission water main on Grand River Avenue from Gill Road to Whittaker Drive capital improvement program for the installation of sewer and water in the Woodcraft Subdivision on a special assessment basis," Dinan's budget message said.

"Street lighting is being designed to be installed on the main arteries and within subdivisions and a high priority for road maintenance in the new area."

The separate water and sewer fund budget, Dinan added, "has been designed to retain the same water rate, afford equipment and improvements to the system, to allocate \$13,000 in the capital improvement fund to provide for sanitary sewer improvements and water main improvements to the system."

Dinan's budgeting reflects an expectation that next winter won't be as bad as the last one. A bit more than \$10,000 was allocated for snow and ice removal last year, but estimated actual expenditures were nearly \$12,800. For the coming year, he is asking \$12,200.

His conservative budgeting forecasts stable or slightly decreasing revenues from
