## Senator Hart Talks Politics at 19th Democratic Dinner

With only a couple of conditions, U.S. Sen. Philip A. Hart supports a federal population control program through birth control.

The Michigan Democrat in Oakland County last Saturday for a party dinner in his honor, also discounted the contention that charges that U.S. autos are unsafe is contributing to the current auto sales slump.

Hart was quizzed about a variety of issues in a press conference preceding his speech.

Asked if he felt there is a world population and if the federal government should have a role in the spreading of either birth control information or devices, Hart said:

"I'm the only Catholic member of the Senate who was a co-sponsor of Sen. Gruening's bill—the Alaska Democrat's bill to set up information programs in the State and Health-Education-Welfare departments.

"I think that, provided there's an absolute assurance that one's moral attitude and principles in this area aren't violated and that welfare is not withheld or conditioned upon one's breaking faith with your own faith, the increasing role of the federal government calls for both information and, wherever requested, of materials."

As for his own church's

traditional position against artificial contraception, Hart declined to get into the theological details, but said: "I can only hope that they change."

Later, in a lighter vein, Hart and newsmen traded jocosities about the Hart brood—eight children.

On the subject of slumping auto sales and the long controversy over safety, Hart said:

"If I were an auto sales manager and my chart were going down, I would certainly suggest that it's a possibility the government's action had something to do with it rather than my sales force."

"Certainly, the public has become increasingly aware of the hazards and welcomes. I think, the effort at all levels to come up with safer vehicles."

"I think the reaction of the automobile industry and its leaders has been good."

"I was on the committee that first wrote that original bill (on safety standards), and it was I who raised the possibility that the feasibility of a safety standard be a factor when we apply it."

In his speech, Hart criticized a move led by Republican Senate Leader Everett M. Dirksen of Illinois to call a national constitutional convention aimed at overthrowing the "one man, one vote" court rule that has led to reapportionment of many state legislatures, including Michigan's.

Thirty-two of the required 34 states have endorsed such a proposal.

"In many cases, state legislatures passed their resolutions before they were reappointed in accordance with the Supreme Court ruling. Are these applications still valid? I doubt it."

Hart said the drive to allow one house of a state legislature to be appointed on some basis other than straight population "stems from the rapid growth of cities and suburbs and the understandable desire of rural areas to conserve their diminishing political power."

The Michigan Legislature has not yet debated a national con-con resolution, although one has been introduced by State Sen. Thomas Schweigert, R-Petoskey.

It is estimated there are 30,000 CF children in the United States. The diagnosis, treatment, care, rental of respiratory therapy equipment is costly. The average cost to the family for each CF child is about \$100 per month for medications, etc.

Research seeks better methods of control to compensate for this lack in the CF child — and the CF foundation is also doing research as to the cause.
