She loves the gardening hobby she shares with her husband and their two daughters, 13-year-old Mary Eileen and Ladonna Marie, 10. She encourages the girls in their interests in Girl Scouts and school activities.

She finds her college work fascinating, and has learned that interest in one art form leads to knowing more about others. "You know," she said, "we have to write a paper for our final exam in art."

Mrs. Reddington thinks she would like to work with senior citizens when she finishes school and gets around to teaching.

"My mother is a widow," she explained, "and knowing her friends I've learned their need for creative outlets as they have more time. And they have so much wisdom to share."

The flower arranging for youngsters last summer was a delight to both teachers and participants, and in a wealth of entries for the Association's September exhibition.

"Some of the teenagers showed lots of talent," their teacher said, "and we even had little boys displaying their bug collections. The kids are asking now when we're going to have classes this year. We'll do it if we can find the time."

That's really Eileen Reddington's biggest problem — to find days long enough for all the non-outstanding things she'd like to do.
