Label Reading Know-how Needed to Buy Hot Dogs

To know what you're buying when you shop for hot dogs, red-hots, wieners, or frankfurters, read the label.

Nyla Gorham, University of Illinois extension food specialist, explains that the label serves as a "buyer's guide," telling the full story about this great American meat product. The label includes an accurate list of ingredients, starting with predominant item.

All beef franks, as the name implies, are made exclusively with beef.

All meat franks are made exclusively with meat, though it may be a combination of beef, pork, and veal.

Cereal and nonfat dry milk may be added to franks, and imitation franks are also available.

Cereal and nonfat dry milk are added to some frankfurters to help bind the meat. Regulations require that such franks, when produced under federal inspection, cannot contain more than 3.5 percent of either cereal or nonfat dry milk, or a combination of the two.

If the product does contain more than 3.5 percent cereal or nonfat dry milk, or if it has had more than 10 percent moisture added, it must be labeled "Imitation Frankfurters."

The label will show the addition of flavorings and spices, though they need not be listed separately. If artificial smoke flavoring has been used or the casings colored, the label must say so.

Chemicals used as curing agents to preserve the natural red color of the meat must also be listed in the statement of ingredients.

In addition, the label must show the net weight of the package, the name and address of the manufacturer, and the federal meat inspection symbol, which includes the identification number of the packing plant that prepared the franks.

This symbol is applied only to those frankfurters that have passed the test of wholesomeness and truthful labeling.
