Dems Endorse Library Proposal

Farmington Democrats took time out this week from working out final details for the club's annual dinner Monday, May 22 to endorse the Library proposal which will go before Township voters on the same day.

Actually, the two events go together since proceeds from this year's Farmington Democratic Dinner have been pledged for the purchase of a suitable collection of books for the Farmington District Library. The collection will be donated to the Library in the name of Al Landgren, who died recently after years of service to the Democratic Club. The dinner is scheduled for 6:45 p.m. in Botsford Inn, Grand River near Eight Mile Road.

Landgren will be eulogized by another long-time Farmington Democrat, W. Allen Nelson, a member of Farmington City's Planning Commission. Club chairman Gerald Freedman said that any of Mr. Landgren's many friends who still want to buy tickets to the dinner can do so by calling Mrs. Marie Mutschall at 474-8129.

The Democratic Club's resolution in support of the Library pointed out that adoption of the millage proposal on May 22 will benefit all areas of the Farmington community--the northern section by providing a new facility and the southern section by relieving overcrowding at the existing building.

Moreover, we had hoped that the people of the area might be willing to examine several alternatives and not become concentrated on a single one.

"Any points we would make about the advantages and disadvantages of the other alternatives would be likely to be overlooked as irrelevant and any advantages and disadvantages specified for the one alternative paramount in people's minds would run the risk of being viewed by both proponents and opponents as taking sides."

"If, in the future, there is a feeling on the part of local leaders that the Institute could be of assistance we would be pleased to consider what might be worked out on a mutually satisfactory basis," the letter concluded.
