

Divisions Listed for Jaycee Meet

Farmington Jaycees have listed the events to be held during their Junior Champ meet to be held June 17 at Farmington High School.

Listed are: Pee Wee Division (ages 9-10), boys - 60 yd. dash, 100 yd. dash, 220 yd. run, high jump, broad jump; girls - 60 yd. dash, 100 yd. dash, running broad jump.

Junior Division (ages 11-12) boys - 60 yd. dash, 100 yd. dash, 220 yd. run, 440 yd. run, high jump, broad jump, pole vault; girls - 60 yd. run, dash, 100 yd. dash, running broad jump, high jump.

Prep Division (ages 13-14) boys - 100 yd. dash, 220 yd. run, 440 yd. run, 880 yd. run, 70 yd. low hurdles, high jump, broad jump, pole vault, shot put (8 lbs.); girls - 100 yd. dash, 220 yd. run, high jump, running broad jump.

Intermediate Division (ages 15-16) boys - 100 yd. dash, 220 yd. run, 440 yd. run, 880 yd. run, mile run, 120 high hurdles, 180 low hurdles, pole vault, high jump, broad jump, shot put (12 lbs.), hop-step-and-jump; girls - 100 yd. dash, 220 yd. run, 440 yd. run, 880 yd. run, high jump, broad jump.

At the end of the meet, an open two-mile race will be run. Contestants should contact their high school coaches about this event.

Founders Follies Tickets Go On Sale



Tickets for the musical show, which the Farmington Board of Commerce hopes will raise the funds necessary to stage the Third Annual Founders Festival, have been distributed. county, state and federal funds. The local school district revenue or budgets would not be affected by the centers.

Curriculum for the centers would be set with the advice of a citizen committee. The current needs of the employers in the county and the occupational interests of the young people entering the vocational program would be reviewed.

Proponents of the concept of area vocational education assert that the program would allow for better quality vocational training than is possible for the local school districts to support.

Booklet Available

Why should a man with a wife and young children concern himself with anything that seems far away as social security?

A new booklet, "Social Security Information for Young Families," designed to answer this question is now available, according to Pontiac social security district manager, Eino J. Heino.

"Social Security is not just a retirement program, and it is not just for old people," Heino said. This new booklet gives the young worker important information about the survivors and disability protection that he and his family have now.

Nine out of 10 families in Oakland County have social security survivor protection which can amount to over \$75,000 in benefits if the breadwinner in the family should die, he pointed out.

Disability insurance is the other social security program of particular importance to the young worker. After just five years of work under social security, the worker and his family are eligible to receive monthly payments if he should become severely disabled and the condition is expected to last a year or longer.

Heino said that "Social Security Information for Young Families" explains in detail survivors and disability protection, what it can mean to a family, and how to make an application should it become necessary.

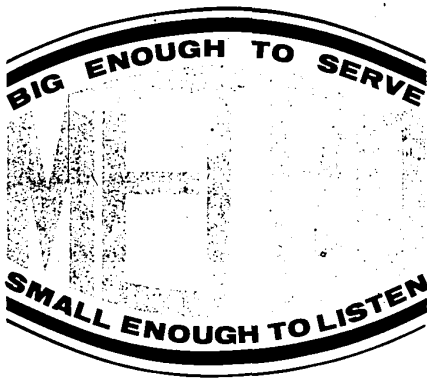
