Distress Call Travels To Arizona From Florida

It happened casually enough. Mrs. Robert Burt of Tucson, Ariz., the former Pat Hayworth of Farmington and the wife of Air Force Capt. Robert Burt of Livonia, was sitting in her living room, knitting and listening to a citizen's band radio.

Suddenly the radio coughed, and out came a distress message from 2000-miles distant off-coast Florida. A fogbound boat in the Gulf of Mexico needed help—and had reached no one.

So, acting like any citizen's band-owner would, Mrs. Burt calmly picked up the phone, reached the Arizona Highway Patrol, who teletyped the Florida State Police, who called the Taylor County, Florida, Sheriff's Office.

They in turn notified the Coast Guard, and the stranded boater — a woman — was

duly rescued. The fact that the radio connection was an entire fluke—experts attributed it to a normal atmospheric conditions—didn't phase Mrs. Burt in the least.

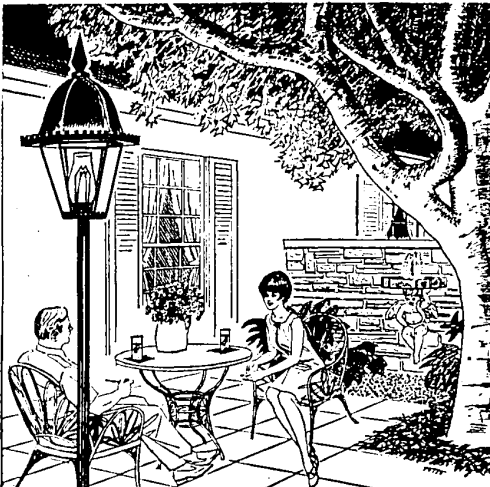

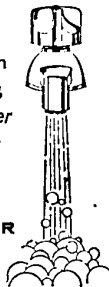

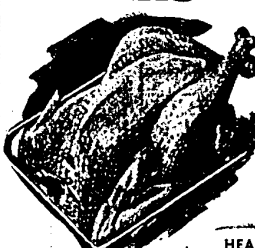
