## Wayne State Offers Play Writing Grants

Harry Albertson, an undergraduate liberal arts student, has been awarded first prize, a cash award of \$300, in Wayne State University's fifth annual playwriting contest.

Tying for second place, and receiving \$100 each, are Samuel J. Miszewski, a graduate student working toward an M.A. degree in the theatre, and Raymond McGlynn, a post-degree theatre student. Winners were announced today by Professor Vincent Wall, chairman of the contest, sponsored jointly by the English Department and University Theatre.

The top winner, Harry Albertson, won for a full length play, "Entitled of Angels." He has acted for eight years in a number of community theatres and has worked for four years in summer stock at Petoskey, Mich.

Samuel J. Miszewski has been an award winner for the past three years, received his \$100 prize for a one act play, "The Wedding Dress." He attended high school in Muskegon and received his B.A. degree from Albion College, where he played leading roles in such productions as "Anthony and Cleopatra," "J.B.," and "Richard II." Raymond McGlynn also received \$100 for a one act play, "Memorial Service."

## Pianist Will Solo At Pops Concert

Detroit's David Syme has won the ninth annual Bendelson Memorial Piano Competition, earning a solo engagement with the Detroit Symphony Orchestra at the State Fairgrounds on Friday, June 23, at 8:30 p.m.

The 18-year-old pianist will be heard in the Rachmaninoff Second Piano Concerto, with Valter Poole conducting.

Syme performed the same concerto with the Community Orchestra last January under the baton of

Julius Chajes, who is Syme's piano teacher. Syme also has studied with Mischa Kottler in Detroit and with Dr. Reid Nibley this past year at the University of Michigan. He plans to enter the Juilliard School of Music this fall.

The Bendelson competition is conducted on a state-wide basis by the Bohemian Musicians Club of Detroit. Syme receives a cash award of \$250 from the Bohemian Club.

Including Syme, four soloists are yet to be heard at "Symphony Under the Stars" performances, and all will be making their symphony debuts.

Sunday's soloists will be the Detroit soprano Jocelyn Krueger, singing Puccini's "Vissi d'arte" and Friml's "L'amour toujours l'amour."

Next Tuesday, Gisela Depkat, who placed second in the recent national Concert Artists' Guild Competition,

will perform the Saint Saens Cello Concerto.

The following Sunday, June 23, at the concluding Fairgrounds concert, baritone William Kellogg will be heard in operatic arias and show tunes.

Poole also will conduct the symphony in a Tchaikovsky program on Wednesday, June 21, and a pop program on Saturday, June 24. All of the concerts are admission-free.
