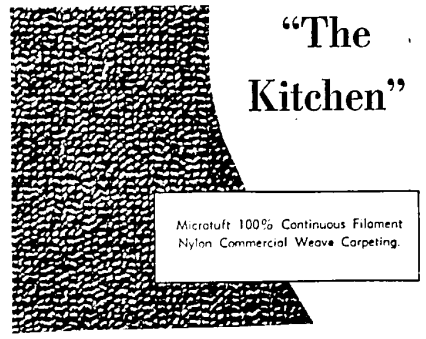

Bob Peppel, Artist: His Life Was a Stage

He was 23 years old at the time of his death. The spirit and talent of Bob Peppel that had budded during his years at Port Hope high school and blossomed in his later years at Michigan State University was suddenly stilled, or so it seemed. Scores who attend his funeral seemed numbed by the fact that so promising a talent would be called away before he had attained the full limit of his potential. Not long after Bob's death, a memorial fund was established at Michigan State in his name. The fund was set up primarily to aid students in music and allied departments who might need money to remain in school. The tribute seemed fitting, in that Bob, himself, had worked his way through college. Although he was working on his masters degree and teaching voice at MSU at the time of his death, Bob had agreed to return to Caseville during the summer months to direct musical productions connected with the Caseville Summer Enrichment Program. He had been associated with the Caseville program for the previous four years. Bob wrote and directed two musicals. The *Bashful Prince*, which he wrote while in high school, was performed at Bangor Township Summer Enrichment Program and the Port Hope school. His second show, *The Village of Ecape*, was presented at the Caseville Summer Enrichment Program. Bob also composed many other songs, one of which, *Carnival in Town*, has been adopted as the theme song for the Water Carnival at Michigan State University. Bob was active in 4-H work and his first performances were in 4-H Share-the-Fun Festivals. He directed a 4-H Huron County Chorus for two years and judged 4-H talent shows throughout the state. Last summer, at the Michigan 4-H Club Week, Bob directed a choir which performed on television. Bob taught at Ubyly High School for a short period and his student teaching in Livonia in the fall of 1965. While pursuing an academic major in music education, which requires a full academic and performance schedule, he also sang in the University Chorus and roles in the MSU Workshop productions of "Gallantry," "The Proposal," and "Trials by Jury." He also performed in the MSU Performing Arts Company production of "Marriage of Figaro." He played the lead, "Tony," in *West Side Story* at MSU last spring. His performance in this role was critically acclaimed, his voice being termed "strong and vibrant" and his expression "the high point of the performance." Bob spent two years writing *The Village of Ecape* under his direction staged last summer. The play depicts a mythical village where inhabitants live free to pursue their individual successes provided they do not conflict with the freedom of their neighbors. The striking contrast to modern history was beautifully conveyed by the young players under Bob's direction. The *Village of Ecape* will again be performed at Caseville, June 30 to July 1, as a tribute to its creator. Most of the original cast will participate in the performance.

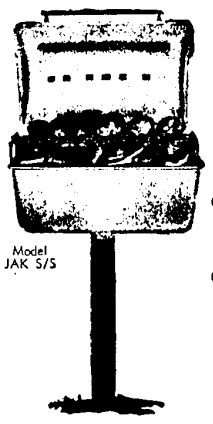
