

# Meadow Brook Shifts Time of Performances

Oakland University's Meadow Brook Festival has changed its Sunday series performance time from 8:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. in response to hundreds of requests. Grounds will open at 8:30 for picnics and buffet service. Six concerts are scheduled in the Baldwin Pavilion for the week ahead.

Thursday, Friday, and Saturday, July 20-21-22, at 8:30 p.m., and next Sunday, July 23, at 7:30, Sixteen Earling will return to the Detroit Symphony from three guest engagements with the Philadelphia Orchestra for the Festival performance with Van Cliburn, pianist, as soloist.

Cliburn will play the Brahms Concerto No. 2 in B flat major Thursday and Friday, and Wagner's Prelude to and on a program which will also feature the world premiere of Eugene Zador's Concerto for Trombone with Allen Chase as soloist. Franz Berwald's Tragic Overture to "Estrella de Sorla" and William Kroll's "Concerto Grosso" are also scheduled.

Saturday and Sunday Cliburn will play the Rachmaninoff Concerto No. 3 in D minor on a program which will include Irwin Bazelon's Symphony No. 2 ("Testimonial to a Big City") and Berg's Violin Concerto with Gordon Staples the soloist.

On Wednesday, July 26, at 8:30 p.m., the Meadow Brook School of Music Orchestra will appear with Robert Shaw and James Levine sharing the podium.

Shaw will conduct Mozart's Symphony No. 38 in D major and Levine will direct Wagner's Prelude to and on a program which will also feature the world premiere of Eugene Zador's Concerto
