Finian's Rainbow, a light-hearted account of Irish immigrants Finian McLonergan's attempt to grow gold in this country, contains a number of spoofs on the foibles and follies of these United States—particularly the state of "Mississippi," the epitome of Mason-Dixon territory.

The elements of a fine midsummer night's entertainment—a well cast group of youthful performers, lively and sparkling dance numbers, and the accompaniment of a live orchestra amid the outdoor pine and evergreen surroundings of the college's Barbara Amphitheatre—make the Hillsdale College summer theatre fare a pleasant and rewarding occasion.

A cast of more than 40 singers and dancers, splendid accompaniment by experienced musicians from Hillsdale College and the Hillsdale area, clever scenery and stage lighting "under the tent," and cool, comfortable outdoor seating for audiences make it well worthwhile for theatre fans to follow the rainbow to Hillsdale.

Scheduled after Finian's Rainbow to round out summer theatre at Hillsdale College is Lionel Bart's "Oliver," based on Charles Dickens' tale of Oliver Twist. Oliver, also designed as an evening's entertainment for all ages, open July 21 and continues July 28, 29, 30 and August 4, 5, 6.

Don Evans, whose singing style has been compared to a combination of Johnny Mathis and Buddy Greco, will appear nightly, except Monday, beginning August 1.

He learned to play the saxophone, clarinet, organ and, of all things, the violin. The versatile singing pianist also has a flair for song writing. Among his hits he has composed are "Send Someone My Way," and a pop tune, "Hey Little Girl."
