Optometrists Offer Visual Screenings

Founders Festival visitors may take a visual screening in the Michigan Optometric Association's trailer, which will be located in Farmington Center July 27-29. Hours the mobile unit will be open are from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. and 4 to 8 p.m. each day. The service provided will be a free visual screening and not an eye examination. People screened will be given a card indicating whether or not they have passed. Those who do not pass will be advised to consult their own optometrist. Performing the screenings will be members of the Women's Auxiliary of the Oakland County Optometric Association and Farmington Lions Club. Sponsors of the service are the Oakland County Optometric Association, Farmington Lions Club and local optometrists.

Mounted Police Set Performance

Missile Is Parade Feature


A five-ton Nike-Hercules air defense missile will be in Farmington Saturday for the Founders Festival parade, and may be on display during the festival in Demery's parking lot. The demonstration missile will come from the Selfridge Air Force Base. Nike-Hercules missiles are the type used in air defense of the Detroit metropolitan area. They are located at six sites


