
# Antiques Fill Century-Old Lorion Home

Going up the curved driveway of the century-old home, one hopes that the grace and charm it promises from the outside will not be marred by Grand Rapida stock furniture on the inside.

Inside,

Here are some of her hints on how to recognize a genuine antique piece of furniture:

e Look for hand plane marks. This tells you it was made before the machine age of furniture production. There was not buch mechanization in furniture—making before Fullop invented the steamboat in 1820.

e Look for back or the These are notches made by ax or saw.

• Look for doyetailing on drawers where the fronts join the backs of the drawer proper.
