Westland Candidates Endorsed

Four Westland organizations endorsed Mayor Thomas Brown and a variety of candidates recently for the Sept. 12 Democratic primary election.

The League of Westland Democratic Voters Wednesday Aug. 16, voted 28-20 to endorse Brown over three challengers and City Council candidates Justice Barnes, incumbent Gene McKinney, Russ Tuttle and Ralph Turco, all challengers.

Also that week, the Westland Committee of Political Education (COPE) steering committee of the UAW-AFL endorsed Brown and three incumbent council members, William Anderson, Paul Krarup, Henry Lundquist, and challenger William Ventura.

The recommendations by the group's steering committee were forwarded to the 15th District's COPE organization by Westland chairman Ben DeHart, and then sent to the Wayne County Council of UAW-AFL for approval.

The steering committee includes Ventura and Jonathan Barnes, husband of Council member Justice Barnes but they did not vote for each other or their spouse.

Last night, the Westland Young Democrats Organization endorsed the same candidates as COPE did.

Westland political candidates were endorsed this week by the "Save Birch Hill Committee" and the Westland Teen Democratic Club.

The Birch Hill group was formed last year during the controversy involving the rezoning request of the Birch Hill Golf Course for a complex of apartments and shopping center. The request was rejected by the City Council this summer and the committee vowed it would support those candidates who agreed with their views.

Carrying out its promise, the committee endorsed Virgil Gagnon for mayor and five candidates for the four City Council seats: Councilwoman Justine Barnes, Sala Aho, John McCormick, Gene McKinney, and Russell Tuttle.

Committee Chairman Bruce Foulk announced that the endorsed candidates "will provide respectable city government not present at this time."

"Not being union or party bound the candidates are all Democrats seeking nominations in the Sept. 12 primary election, we feel this represents the 'peoples endorsements,'" Foulk said.

"If elected, these candidates will correct the deficiencies currently existing and thereby provide a government of progress acceptable to Westland residents."

Douglas Rohloff, Teen Democratic Club president, announced that the group has endorsed Mayor Thomas H. Brown for re-election and Ralph Turco for one of the four Democratic nominations for City Council.

The club president pointed out that "due to lack of information on other candidates, no other endorsements were made, however, further endorsements will be considered at the next scheduled meeting."

Candidate Holds Campaign Dance

Glen Kassel, one of four candidates seeking the Democratic nomination for Westland mayor in the Sept. 12 primary, is planning a campaign dance for 8 p.m., Thursday, Sept. 7, in the Wayne Ford Civic League Hall, 1661 N. Wayne Road.

Kassel said that the event is open to all residents of the city and tickets may be obtained by calling 721-3628 or bought at the door.

The candidate said that he will outline his ten point program for the mayor's office and pinpoint his plans for the position, for which there is no Republican opposition.
