## City Drops Brookdale Program

The Farmington City Council has decided to cease any city promotion of a paving program on Brookdale Avenue between Grand River and Nine Mile Road.

The council acted Tuesday after City Manager John Dinan reported a "poor response" from residents.

Asphalt paving and improved drainage would cost \$5 per linear foot, and curb and gutter would cost an additional \$3.50 a foot, Dinan said.

Dinan told the council: "Response to our inquiry has been relatively poor. Out of 39 questionnaires, we have only received 16 returns."

Eight favored asphalt deep strength paving, and six of the eight wanted curb and gutter. The other eight were not interested in a paving program.

"Based on the results of this questionnaire and poor response, we believe that the majority of the people on Brookdale are not interested in an asphalt paving program..."
