Guns Can Be Carried In Trunk

The Oakland County prosecutor's office reversed itself this week and issued a legal opinion contradicting its previously announced policy concerning legality of transporting handguns for target and hunting purposes. Township Police Chief Irving Yakes, who earlier had announced that because of an amendment to Michigan law pistol owners would need a concealed weapon license, said a clarification has been received from Prosecutor S. Jerome Bronson.

"Our previous construction of Act 158 was, in our view, not constitutional," said the announcement from the prosecutor's office.

"A person may still transport a weapon without a concealed weapons license if that weapon is unloaded, broken down and locked in the trunk of the car. A citizen need not obtain any license from the concealed weapons board to purchase a handgun, in the hands of the local police departments. Hunting and target permits still will be issued by the gun board to pistol owners, but the mere act of transporting a handgun will not be considered a concealed weapon violation if the weapon is unloaded and locked in an automobile trunk."

Pedestrian Death Is 4th Fatality

Farmington Township's fourth traffic fatality of the year claimed the life Sunday night of a 41-year-old Brighton resident who was struck on I-696 freeway as he was walking back to his car with a can of gasoline.

Charles Lewis Gibson, of 1419 Richest Rd., Brighton, had left his vehicle on I-696 near Inkster Rd. after running out of fuel, and upon his return was struck by an automobile driven by Jack Eugene Evans, 39, of 308 S. Holly, Fenton.

Township Police Chief Irving H. Yakes said it appeared no criminal action would be taken against Evans. The accident occurred at approximately 10:30 p.m. Sunday.

Although it brought the Township's traffic fatality total for 1967 to four, this still is far short of the 1966 record of 11 such deaths. Another serious accident in the Township late last Saturday night left four people injured and one's health endangered, charges of disregarding a red traffic signal.

David P. Gibson, 60, of 16783 Bloomfield, Livonia, was ticketed for the alleged violation after crashing at 12 Mile and Middle Belt Rds. with a vehicle driven by Raymond L.

No Date Set Yet For Early Trial

John Early, of Farmington Township, facing trial on a charge of assault with intent to murder his estranged wife, Shirley, Aug. 1, stood mute upon his Circuit Court arraignment in Pontiac.

Judge Arthur Moore ordered Early not to plead guilty and continued bond at \$25,000. No trial date was set, however.

Teens Needed To Help Wrap Christmas Gifts


