but points to neighboring communities which are supporting comprehensive Mott-supported programs which go far beyond YGC pilot suggestions.

THE YGC also cites the concrete fact that the initial step to promote a Mott program must come from some source.

Statistics support the YGC contention that something is needed to put prevention of anti-social behavior on a level with the people.

In 1962 there were 33 reported cases of vandalism by youth. In 1965 there were 64, a 100 per cent increase. There were 66 reported thefts

by youth in 1962, 110 in 1965, a 18 per cent increase.

Committee figures show that almost every area of crime among youth from sex offenses to brutality increased by 80 per cent from 1962 to 1965.

Such computations make a strong case for continued YGC efforts in the prevention of delinquency and neglect.

Schools Seek \$9 Million In Bonds

expenses, not construction necessities.

IF IT GETS voter permission to increase its bonded debt by \$9 million, the Board of Education will spend it on these projects:

Two new elementary schools to be ready for classes by 1969 and 1971, Harrison High School to open in 1969, another junior high school to be finished by 1972, plus purchase, as the amount of remaining money allows, of additional school sites for future buildings.

The Farmington School District has an enrollment at the moment of 15,248 pupils.

It has classroom capacity for 16,686, but projections show the enrollment will pass the 17,000 level by 1969—and 20,000 before the end of the 1972 school year.

Spokesmen for the board say this "will require 153 additional classrooms to provide space for these additional children."

Their answer for providing that space lies in those four new schools already mentioned. In fact, to avoid immediate construction of still another junior high school, it is planned to use Harrison's facilities for junior high pupils, as well as high school students, during the first four years of its existence.

HOW ACCURATE are these year-by-year enrollment projections?

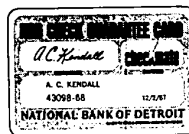
First of all, it is a statistical fact that the number of students has been climbing steadily for more than a decade. It has gone up every single year since 1956, with the average growth since 1962 holding steady at just about 900 new pupils per year.

Secondly, school administration analysts function in extremely close cohesion with City and Township Planning Commissions, subdividers, land development companies and builders and know far in advance what the new pockets of population influx will be—and how many families will be included.

Thirdly, the great accuracy of past enrollment and population projections leads to faith in the contention that today's look into the future probably

will be equally accurate. For instance, in 1963 the official projection was that the enrollment would increase from 11,739 to 14,329 by 1966. The

prediction missed by only 29 students. In that same year, 1963, it was anticipated enrollment would exceed 15,000 in 1967.
